

Observing Good “Petiquette”

- 1** This off leash area (OLA) is for DOGS and their people. No other animals are permitted.
- 2** Your dog must be on leash when entering and exiting the off leash area (OLA).
- 3** Your dog must be vaccinated, licensed, and wear the appropriate tags.
- 4** Your dog must respond to voice or hand commands. Remove your dog from the OLA at the first sign of aggression.
- 5** If your dog is under four months old, a female in heat, or sick, please bring them another time.
- 6** Always clean up after your dog. Even pick up another dog’s waste if their owner has missed it, or kindly notify the owner.
- 7** Do not allow your dog to jump on people.
- 8** You’re responsible for any holes or damage created by your dog.
- 9** Don’t bring in food and drinks in glass containers.
- 10** Pick up any trash you find. Cigarette butts and plastic can end up in a dog’s mouth!
- 11** Be respectful of homeowners who live adjacent to the OLA.
- 12** Remember, you’re using the OLA at your own risk!
