Replacement Requirement: VMC 12.04 requires replanting of one tree for every tree removed. Replacement trees must be:

- a species on the City of Vancouver Approved Street Tree Selection list
- nursery-grown, at least 1.5" caliper, and Washington Nursery Grade #1
- maintained through successful establishment; if replacement tree dies, it must be replanted
- planted on the same site, unless other arrangements are made at the time permit is approved

Street Tree Removal Criteria: A street tree removal permit will be granted if the adjacent property owner can sufficiently demonstrate that the public benefit provided by the tree is outweighed by significant tree defects. Trees that are determined by the City Forester to be dead, dying, "hazard trees" or "inappropriate species" are automatic candidates for removal. The following facts shall NOT be considered as criteria for removal of a street tree:

- obstruction of view
- potential future damage to public infrastructure or private property, if that damage can be avoided by root pruning, root barriers, or other management strategies
- the cost of routine tree maintenance (pruning, watering, fertilizing, spraying)
- normal maintenance activities such as the raking of leaves and flowers and cleaning of gutters
- hazards that can be controlled or eliminated through appropriate pruning or maintenance

The stumps and roots of trees or shrubs shall be removed to a point at least one foot below the top of the adjacent curb or proposed curb grade.

Major Pruning

Major pruning is defined as:

- pruning branches greater than three inches in diameter
- pruning roots, or
- removing greater than 15% of the tree's total canopy.

Major pruning **must** be performed according to American National Standards Institute (ANSI)A300 guidelines by an individual or company with a valid City of Vancouver **Street Tree Worker License** (contact Urban Forestry for current list)
