Impact Northwest Kids on the Block Puppeteers work in teams of two volunteers to present scripted educational programs to elementary school and community group audiences on important topics ranging from drug abuse prevention, healthy eating habits and physical activity, to learning about personal safety and child abuse. Volunteers are needed; all training, equipment and materials are provided.
