ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE fixing and levying the amount of ad valorem taxes necessary to balance estimated revenues with estimated expenditures for the 2010 Budget for the City of Vancouver; providing for an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the total net amount of \$40,100,000 in revenue must be raised by ad valorem taxes on real and personal property within the corporate limits of the City of Vancouver to balance estimated revenues and expenditures for the 2010 budget for the City of Vancouver.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF VANCOUVER:

Section 1. There is hereby fixed to be raised by general property taxes upon real and personal property within the City of Vancouver the amount of \$40,100,000, for the following purposes:

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to transmit and file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Board of Clark County Commissioners and the Clark County Assessor following approval by City Council.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect five days after adoption.
