

**HEARING NOTICE  
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT  
CONSOLIDATED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT 2010 ACTION**

A public hearing will be held on Friday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10:00 am at 1610 C Street, Suite 203, Vancouver, WA, 98663 to amend the 2010 City of Vancouver Consolidated Housing and Community Development Action Plan. Citizens' comments are welcomed and encouraged regarding the following proposed changes. The projects listed below were funded with CDBG funds by both Vancouver and Clark County. In order to streamline processes the following project changes are being proposed.

**Proposed Changes to 2010 Action Plan**

**Cancel Funding: Clark County Food Bank – Warehouse and Distribution Center Construction/Rehab Project.** Cancel \$224,000 of CDBG funding. This project will be funded with Clark County CDBG funds.

**Increase Funding: Share - ASPIRE.** Increase CDBG funding \$40,000 - total CDBG funding will change from \$50,000 to \$90,000.

**Increase Funding: Share - Service Center.** Increase CDBG funding \$50,000 - total CDBG funding will change from \$50,000 to \$100,000.

**Increase Funding: Columbia Non-profit Housing - First Home Loan Program.** Increase CDBG funding \$34,000 - total CDBG funding will change from \$69,850 to \$103,850.

**Increase Funding: Vancouver Housing Authority - Shelter Improvements Project.** Increase CDBG funding \$100,000 - total CDBG funding will change from \$100,000 to \$200,000.
