NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM 2 (NSP2)

Citizens' comments are welcomed and encouraged regarding the City of Vancouver's participation in applying for Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 (NSP2) funding. The application is being coordinated by the National Development Council (NDC) in conjunction with other member cities throughout the nation. Overall funding is in part provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and authorized under the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009. Approximately 50 million dollars of funding is being requested in the NDC application to purchase foreclosed properties. Based on data from HUD, the eligible census tracts within the City of Vancouver are 0413.24 – Fisher's Landing East, Bennington, and Northfield Neighborhoods, and 0418.00 – Rose Village Neighborhood.
