The Clark County Aging Readiness Plan assesses the county's readiness to serve as a home for a growing number of older residents. The plan includes strategies to improve the community's capacity to support its growing older population and ultimately benefit people of all ages. The plan covers the topics of housing, transportation/mobility, health care, support services, and civic activities.

The Commission on Aging is updating the Aging Readiness Plan and wants public feedback to help assess implementation to date, refine existing strategies, brainstorm new ideas for the updated

plan, and guide the creation of a new chapter focused on emergency preparedness.
