- How can your family—on any budget—prepare for such an event?

We are fortunate to have an opportunity to hear the answers to these questions and more from Jodi Blackwood, Program Manager for the Clark County Community Emergency Response Team (CERT). Jodi has firsthand knowledge of emergency management and works with families and neighborhoods across Southwest Washington to help them prepare for a potential disaster. She will share with us workable, budget-conscious options and resources, and present ways that we can use the strengths in our neighborhood to help all of us get through. This knowledge could make a real difference in how we cope in the event of a natural or man-made disaster.
