BYLAWS FOR FATHER BLANCHET PARK NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION

I. NAME

The name of this association shall be called the Father Blanchet Park Neighborhood Association, hereafter shall be referred to as "Association".

II. OBJECT

The Association is established by the residents of the Father Blanchet Park neighborhood in order to unite the common interests and promote the welfare of the neighborhood and its residents. The Association shall concern itself with a variety of issues including, but not limited to, matters affecting livability and quality of the neighborhood and the community in general.

III. BOUNDARIES

NORTH: Mac Arthur Blvd.

SOUTH: Highway 14

WEST: S. Andresen Road

EAST: Friedel Avenue

IV. MEMBERSHIP

The membership of the Association is open to all property owners, residents, home owners, managers of multi-family dwellings, non-profit organizations and business owners or managers within the boundaries of this neighborhood.

V. OFFICERS

The officers of the Association shall be a chairperson, vice chairperson and secretary/treasurer. The above officers shall preside over all meetings, planning sessions and activities of the Neighborhood Association.

VI. MEETINGS

The Association shall meet not less than quarterly to discuss neighborhood business. All decisions must be reached by majority vote of the membership attending the general meeting.

VII. EXECUTIVE BOARD

Members of the Executive Board will include the officers and the committee chairpersons. All officers must reside within the boundaries of the neighborhood. All decisions made by the Board must be confirmed by a meeting of the general membership.

VIII. COMMITTEES

Special committees to handle specific concerns may be appointed by the chairperson as necessary.

IX. VOTING

All eligible members eighteen (18) years old and older are entitled to one (1) vote.

X. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Officers shall be elected annually. Elections to refill vacant positions shall take place whenever such vacancies occur.

XI. AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS

These bylaws may be amended at any general meeting by a simple majority vote, the proposed amendments having been submitted in writing and distributed to the membership prior to a general meeting at least one week before voted upon.

XII. FUNDING

Voluntary contributions, contracts, grants, subscriptions or fund-raising activities may be used by the Association.
