The Marrion Neighborhood Association (MNA) has been in effect for over 25 years! The neighborhood boundary lies in the area north of NE Mill Plain BLVD, to NE 18th St, and east of NE 97th Ave, to I-205.

We consist of approximately 1400 homes and 3k people!

We are not an HOA, there is **no fee** to be part of MNA, and if you live or have a business within the neighborhood boundary, you are part of the Marrion Neighborhood Association general members already.

So, what does a Neighborhood association actually do??

*Neighborhood volunteers work with you and the City of Vancouver to provide FREE services, like the **Annual Neighborhood Cleanup on July 15th, 23' from 8 am-1:45 pm.**

*Work with the City on projects that are important to our neighborhood, like the paving project and crosswalk painting on 104th St. in front of hotel and Walmart.

*Vancouver Mayor, Anne McEnerny-Ogle, often attends our meetings and hears our concerns and shares updates on city projects.

*Neighborhood Police officer, Nicole Vigil, often attends and shares safety tips and provides information on how best to report and respond to crime.

*Neighborhood watch coordination!

*Traffic concerns, such as speeding issues, stop sign needs, etc.

MNA (Marrion Neighborhood Association) started the Neighborhood Watch in May of 22'. Residents wanted to do more to support their neighbors and help protect everyone's property, and provide more safety.

What we are currently working on:

*Creating a solid group of Volunteer "mini-leads" who will serve as a point of contact for safety and crime concerns in their "pocket" in our neighborhood.

If you walk your area regularly, or drive a particular route, or watch out a window, and notice suspicious activity, you can report it to a lead, the neighborhood association board, or our neighborhood officer directly. Email contact available in the information margin.

*Creating a list of neighbors with security cameras, or doorbell cams, so we can obtain footage in the event of an incident.

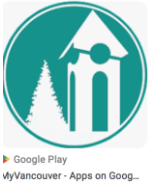
*We are taking donations to purchase more **Neighborhood Watch Signs!**

If you are interested in supporting this effort, or would like a sign for your specific area, signs cost \$44 and are 18"x24" for a metal reflective sign.

Annual neighborhood Cleanup
Saturday, July 15, 2023: 8am-1:30pm

The City of Vancouver rewards neighborhoods that recycle and reuse at cleanup events. We need to do 3 of the following to qualify for a reward.

- 1. Separate yard debris and bulky items**
- 2. Divert reusable items for a community garage sale/donate to local charity**
- 3. Collect lawn mowers for high school small engine program**
- 4. Collect scrap metal for recycling**

These Items are NOT ACCEPTED:

- *NO Household trash or contractor waste**
- *NO large or heavy quantities of CONCRETE, CEMENT, ROCKS, SOD, DIRT**
- *NO home project/remodel debris (i.e. sheet rock, paint, fencing etc.)**
- *NO Roofing shingles**
- *NO Hazardous chemicals (paints, stains, automotive fluids)**
- *NO T.V.'s, computers/electronics (recycle through Washington E-cycle www.ecyclewashington.org)**
- *NO extremely large items (boats, hot tubs etc. Take these to the transfer station)**

Items ACCEPTED at the cleanup:

- *Bulky items:** broken/worn out items too large to fit in your home garbage
- *Scrap Metal** (separate container; metal BBQ's, bicycles, lawn furniture, mowers, car parts/small engines; **fluids drained**, **NON FREON** metal appliances).
- *Yard Debris** (separate container) Branches, grass, leaves, vines, bramble, yard/garden trimmings. **CHIPPER AVAILABLE 8 AM- 12 PM**

PREPARE YOUR LOAD:

- *Categorize your load –Separate material** for easy unloading into donation/garage sale area for items still usable, bulky items truck, yard debris truck, metals recycling box
- *Cover your load**
- *Come prepared to unload what you bring to the cleanup** (leather gloves/tools to unload)

City of Vancouver Garbage/Recycling Neighborhood Programs

***Free Disposal of Yard Debris& tires| Spring**

Residents receive one set of coupons for free yard debris & tire disposal. 2 coupons for yard debris (\$60 value) & 1 free coupon for passenger tires (4 max) April-June.

***Free Bulky item pick up 1x/yr.** Residents with garbage service are eligible for 1 free curbside disposal of up to 5 bulky items weighing less than 100lbs each

***Annual Used Appliance pickup 1x/yr.** Residents with garbage service may schedule 1 free pickup of a major appliance. Call: 360-892-5370
