



Hold Harmless Agreement
PARADE, RUN, WALK, FOOD VENDOR, SIDEWALK SALE, OUTDOOR SEATING

Whereas, [blank] ("Grantee") has applied for a Street Use permit under City Ordinance codified at VMC 11.60.040.

NOW, therefore, Grantee on behalf of itself, its agents, heirs and assigns, and in consideration of the grant of the Street Permit, and other good and adequate consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the City of Vancouver, its appointed and elected officers, employees, agents and assigns from any and all claims which may arise or be claimed to arise as a result of granting this permit.

This indemnity and hold harmless shall include any claim made against the City by an employee or agent of Grantee even if Grantee is otherwise immune from liability pursuant to the workers' compensation statute, Title 51 RCW. Grantee is responsible for the safety of its employees. The duty to defend and indemnify in this permit shall not apply to claims resulting from the sole negligence of the City. In the event of concurrent negligence between Grantee and the City of Vancouver, the duty to defend and indemnify is limited to the extent of the Grantee's negligence. Grantee specifically acknowledges that the provisions contained herein have been mutually negotiated by the parties and it is the intent of the parties that Grantee provide the broadest scope of indemnity permitted by RCW 4.24.115.

Grantee shall obtain and maintain a general liability insurance policy naming the City of Vancouver as Additional Insured. The minimum amount of coverage in this policy shall be \$2,000,000 general aggregate, \$1,000,000 personal injury and \$1,000,000 each occurrence.
