

# TAKING CARE OF OUR STREETS

## Pavement Management

*Your street is among the many scheduled for this year's City of Vancouver Pavement Management Program. Please save this card and use as a helpful reference for information and contacts.*

### WHEN WILL WORK OCCUR?

Pavement preservation and pavement resurfacing typically occur from July to September each year. Schedules are listed in the notices you receive and on the Pavement Management webpage. Please note: Rain and other conditions can affect schedules. If work is delayed due to rain or other issues, you will receive a new notice prior to work taking place.

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

The following preparations, where required, will be done April to June in advance of street work:

- Trimming trees and vegetation
- Filling potholes and sealing cracks
- Constructing ADA-compliant curb ramps

Next comes the actual preservation or resurfacing of the street. Any needed restriping will follow later.

# HANDY REFERENCE GUIDE

- Watch for no parking signs. Do not park on streets when work is scheduled. Vehicles will be towed if remaining on posted streets when crews arrive and work is ready to begin.
- Keep vehicles, bikes, people and pets off the street's surface until the contractor has reopened the street to traffic. Don't risk getting material on your vehicle or tracking it onto your driveway.
- Be prepared for delays. Plan ahead to avoid schedule conflicts while the street is closed.
- Do not water or irrigate yards the day before or day of work. Turn off automatic sprinklers.
- If your regular garbage/recycling collection is the same day as the scheduled work, please set out carts at 5:30 a.m. for pickup. Mail delivery may be delayed a day, however.
- If any restriping is needed, this will follow later. Please do not drive over the wet paint.
