Over the Counter COVID-19 tests	Covered up to 8 per enrolled member per month at no cost	<p>Will <i>NOT</i> be covered (consistent with pre-COVID benefits)</p> <p>Lisa Takach motioned to accept the change effective 5/12/23 for Over the Counter COVID-19 tests to no longer be covered unless they can also be covered under the Kaiser plan. Iasmina seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.</p>
Treatment for COVID-19	<p>Covered at regular plan cost shares both in and out of network</p> <p><i>*CoV changed from zero cost share on 10/1/21</i></p>	Will <i>continue</i> to be covered at regular plan cost shares both in and out of network
Telehealth	<p>Expanded flexibility for virtual care services that would otherwise require in-person service</p> <p><i>*Does not apply to CoV</i></p>	Will <i>continue</i> to offer expanded flexibility for many services that would otherwise require in-person service.
Claims submission, appeals, and extended eligibility windows	Timely filing requirements on claims and appeals were temporarily paused during the PHE	<p>Will return to regular (pre COVID) timelines</p> <p>Lisa Takach motioned to accept the change effective 5/12/23 to allow the claims submission, appeals, and extended eligibility windows to return to regular (pre COVID) timelines.
