ON-STREET PERMIT PARKING

Where can I park with a permit?

The downtown parking map on the back of this flyer provides the general location of on-street permit stalls. Only park in spaces clearly signed as permit parking stalls. Below are the only signs that designate where on-street permits are valid:



An on-street parking permit **does not** give you the ability to park in any on-street parking spot. It is your responsibility to observe all posted rules and abide by all applicable City and state parking rules, regulations and ordinances.

How should I display my permit?

Parking permits must be displayed on the inside of your windshield on the driver's side. It must be clearly visible from outside the car and it should not block your view of the road. (VMC 9.68.170 & RCW 46.37.410).

The enforcement officer must be able to see the entire barcode and permit number to verify that your permit is current, so do not place the permit in a tinted area of your windshield. Parking permits are not tracked by license plate number. Failure to display the permit as required could result in a citation.

How do I renew my permit?

Parking permits expire at midnight on the last day of the calendar month of the purchase period. To avoid losing your permit and possibly being added to a waiting list in order to get a new one, please remember to renew your permit **before** it expires.
