Factory built chimneys shall be installed and terminated in accordance with the manufacturer's installation instructions.

Masonry chimneys that extends through a deck cover for residential-type chimney shall extend at least 3 feet (914 mm) above the highest point where they pass through a roof of a building and at least 2 feet (610 mm) higher than any portion of a building within a horizontal distance of 10 feet.
