Charter Review Timeline

Orientation, Committee Charge, Adoption of Ground Rules, Review of Process, Opening Remarks by the Mayor



Notify auditors

office of ballot





Decision Making Process

Consensus:

"Willing to live with the decision".



Agreement.

Willing to move forward.

Deliberation and space for those not in agreement to express dissent.
