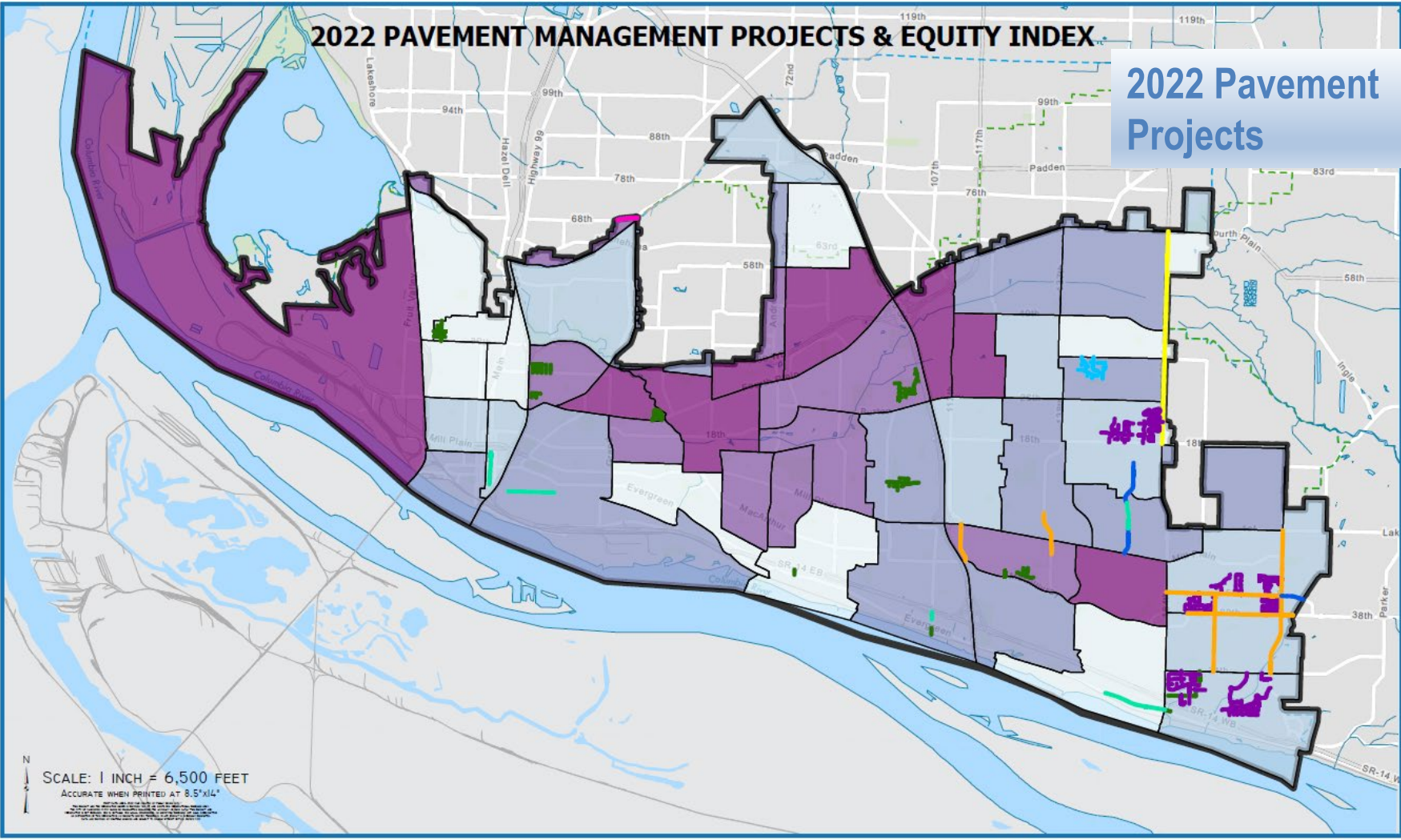

2022 Pavement Projects

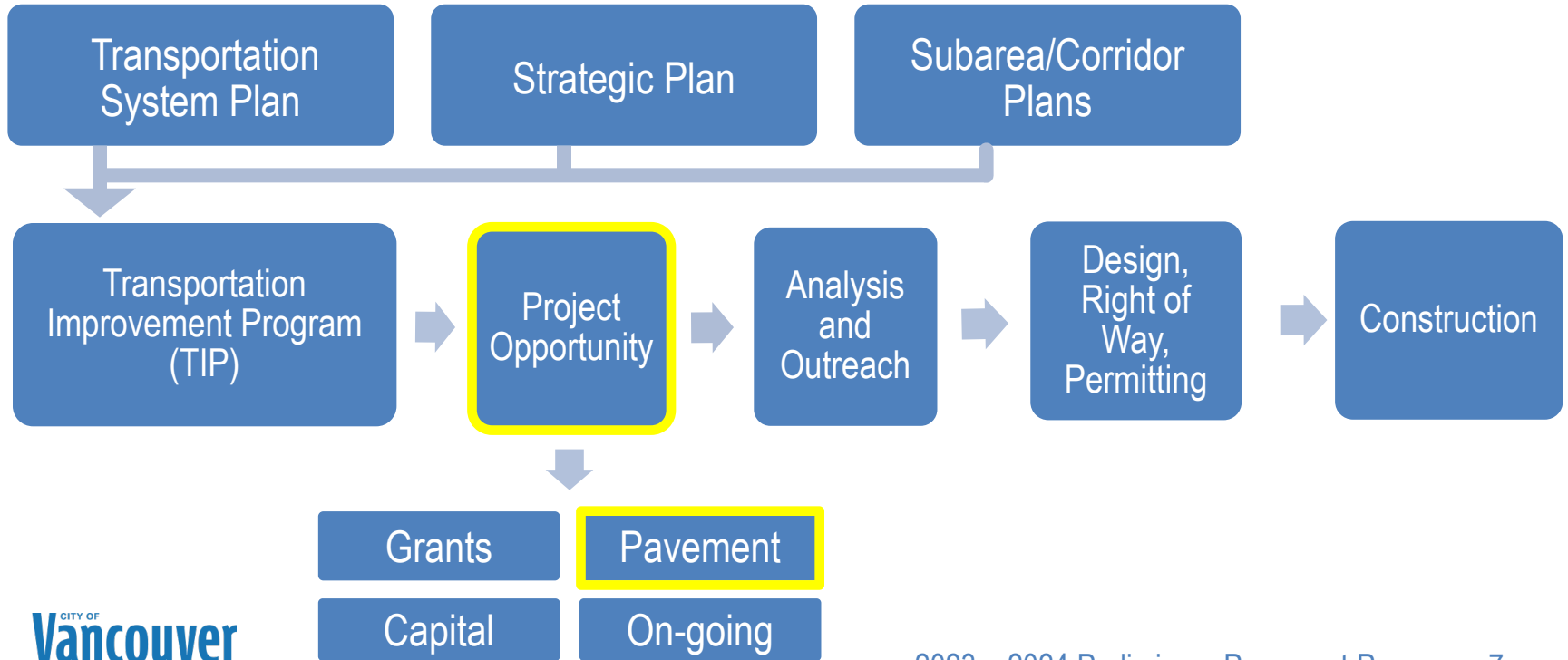

2022 Pavement Management Program - Schedule

- Broadway Improvements – Under Construction
- Curb Ramps – Under Construction
- Pavement Repairs and Surface Prep – Construction in May
- Preservation Work – July and August
- Paving and Rehabilitation Work – July to September
- Re-striping of Streets – August and September

Transportation Project Pipeline



Pavement Project Opportunities (1 of 3)

- Opportunity to improve striping for traffic flow, bikes, and pedestrians (safety and mobility)
- In addition to Council endorsed Complete Streets projects
- Limited in scope
- Easily implemented without additional planning studies or significant public outreach

Pavement Project Opportunities (cont. 2 of 3)

Typical Opportunities to Consider

- Lane widths
- Bike lanes – new, widened, buffered
- Widened shoulders
- Crosswalk striping – ladder, new if lighting is adequate
- Shared use symbols
- Green paint markings
- Parking configurations (e.g. parallel to angled)

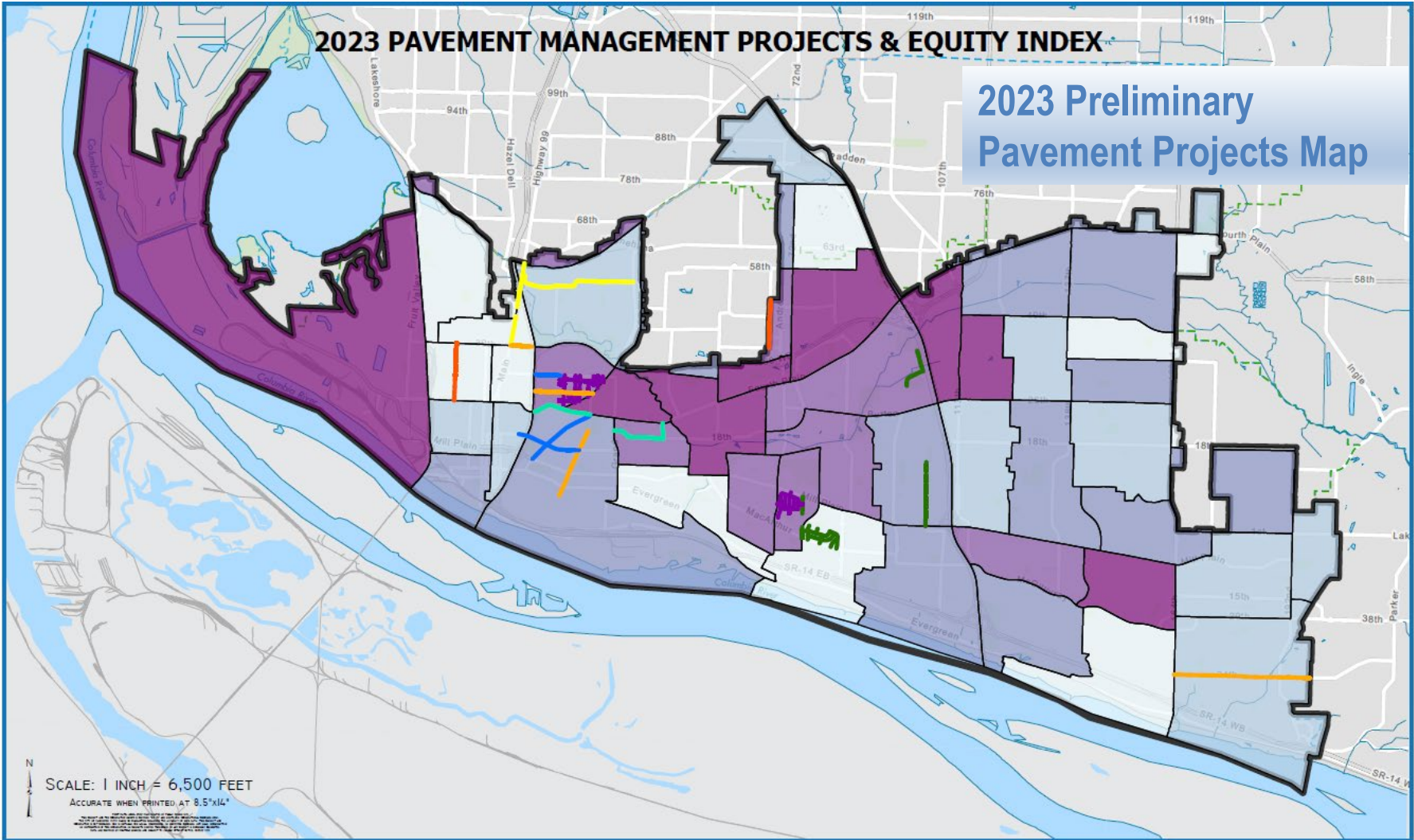
Pavement Project Opportunities (cont. 3 of 3)

Items that would require a separate planning or outreach effort

- Reduction in the number of travel lanes
- Removal of parking
- Removal of turn lanes
- New traffic calming devices

2023 Preliminary Pavement Projects (1 of 3)

- 4th Plain Blvd: Main St. to Ft. Vancouver Way
- Ft. Vancouver Way: Mill Plain Blvd. to 4th Plain Blvd.
- McLoughlin Blvd: F St. to Brandt Rd.
- Vancouver Heights and Oakbrook: Street Rehabilitation
- SE 34th Street: SE 164th Ave. to SE Payne Rd.
- NE 54th Street and NE 49th Street
- Preservation work west of I-205

2023 Preliminary Pavement Projects (cont. 2 of 3)

Council Approved and Funded Complete Streets Projects slated to be implemented in 2023:

- 4th Plain Blvd: Main St. to Ft. Vancouver Way
- Ft. Vancouver Way: Mill Plain Blvd. to 4th Plain Blvd.
- McLoughlin Blvd: F St. to Brandt Rd.
- SE 34th Street: SE 164th Ave. to SE 192nd Ave.

2023 Preliminary Pavement Projects (cont. 3 of 3)

Opportunity Streets slated to receive pavement treatment in 2023:

- Kauffman: 4th Plain Blvd. to W 39th St.
- E 29th Street: I-5 to St. Johns Blvd.
- Ross/NE 54th Street: Hwy 99 to St. James Blvd.
- NE 49th Street: NE 15th Ave. to St. James Blvd. (NTSA)
- NE 104th Avenue: Mill Plain to NE 14th Street

2024 Preliminary Pavement Projects (1 of 2)

- 4th Plain Blvd: Ft. Vancouver Way to Andresen Road
- NE 112th Avenue: Mill Plain Blvd. to 4th Plain Blvd.
- SE McGillivray Blvd: Chkalov Dr. to SE 164th Ave.
- SE 164th Ave, SE Mill Plain, SE 192nd Ave
- Vancouver Heights and Cascade: Street Rehabilitation
- Evergreen Highway: SE 164th Ave. to City limits
- Preservation work east of I-205

2024 Preliminary Pavement Projects (cont. 2 of 2)

Council Approved Complete Streets Projects:

- 4th Plain Blvd: Ft. Vancouver Way to Andresen Road
- NE 112th Avenue: Mill Plain Blvd. to 4th Plain Blvd.
- SE McGillivray Blvd: Chkalov Dr. to SE 164th Ave.

Opportunity Streets:

- NE 9th Street: NE 112th Ave. to NE 125th Ave.
- NE 136th Avenue: SE 4th St. to NE 18th St.
