

Project Corridor Elements

- Parking-protected and buffered ziclaprotected mobility lanes
- Sharrow marked lanes
- On-street parking removal
- Enhanced and marked crosswalks pedestrian crossing with lighting
- Bike boxes and bike lane extensions
- Bike and pedestrian counters
- Education and enforcement activities





Evaluation Process



Milestones

 One month (Fall 2022), six months (Spring 2023) and twelve months (Fall 2023)

Data Collection

• Quantitative (e.g. speed and volume counts) and qualitative (e.g. surveys)

Potential Outcomes

• Refinements and recommendations



One Month Evaluation Outreach



User Survey

- Audience: people who have used the new mobility facilities
- Outreach: intercept on the corridor, QR code yard signs on the corridor, online

Neighbor Survey

- Audience: residents and business owners on or adjacent to the corridor
- Outreach: mailed post cards to 1,700 addresses, QR code yard signs, online
