- Southern Terminus: Vancouver Waterfront
- Northern Terminus: Salmon Creek/WSU Vancouver)
- Jurisdictions: Clark County & City of Vancouver
- Major North-South spine in Vancouver and Clark County
- Third busiest transit corridor in the region




### **Draft Locally Preferred Alternative**
