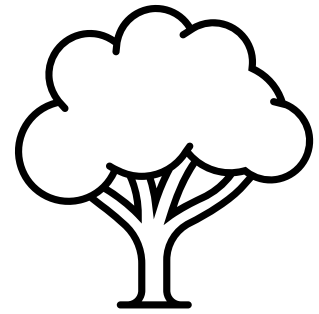

The Oak Tree In My Yard Is My Nemesis

I have one of the largest oak trees in the city limits residing in my yard. Every year around October 15th, the annual leaf dump starts. I do my best to keep on top of the deluge but the weather dictates when I can best clean up the mess this tree creates. I have bagged over 60 large leaf bags in years past. Every year I watch for information on the leaf dumpsters. They are truly a labor saver for me and anyone who has more than a couple bags of leaves to manage.



We are including the information below from Vancouver Public Works regarding the schedule and location of the leaf dumpsters this year. You should also receive this information in a postcard in the mail. Please take advantage of this service and follow the guidelines listed. Spread the word and let your neighbors know. If you have neighbors that aren't able to manage their leaves, offer to lend them a hand and help dispose of their leaves using this free service. Especially, help us keep leaves out of our neighborhood streets where they can clog storm drains. We can all do our part to help keep the Shumway neighborhood sparkling.

Shumway Leaf Recycling

Vancouver Public Works Operations crews will be placing a leaf box in your neighborhood the weekends of November 18 & 19 and December 2 & 3 for the convenience of residents there. Look for a leaf box near:

E 26th Street and H Street

The leaf box will typically be placed by late Friday afternoon and picked up early Monday morning of the weekends noted above. This City of Vancouver Solid Waste program helps those in leafy neighborhoods who may not be able to haul leaves to free coupon drop-off sites. Please remember:

- **LEAVES ONLY:** No other yard debris nor any garbage is allowed in the leaf box.
- **NO PLASTIC BAGS:** If you use plastic bags for transporting, empty leaves into the box. Then take bags home for reuse or toss into your garbage cart.
- **DON'T PUT LEAVES IN STREETS:** Help prevent flooding. Never blow or rake leaves into the street where they clog storm drains. The City does not pick up leaves.
- **CHECK BACK:** If you don't see the leaf box at its designated location, crews have most likely removed the box to be emptied. Please check back in an hour or so, as it should be returned by that time. Thank you for your patience.

NOTE: Please avoid parking in this location during the weekends listed above.

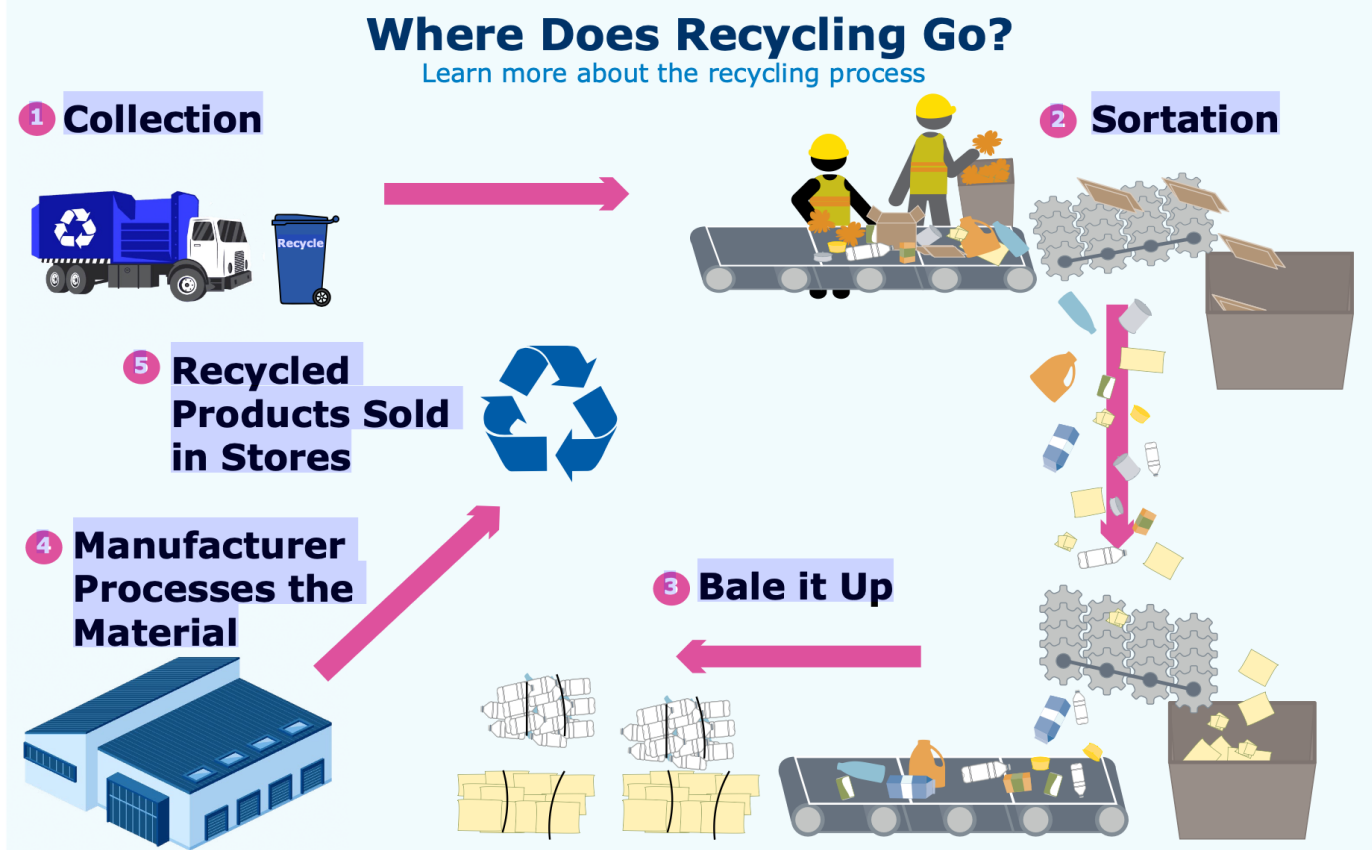
