ROAD2HOME SAFE PARK CODE OF CONDUCT

At Road2Home Safe Park, our mission is unwavering and clear: we exist to provide not just a safe place to park your vehicle, but a robust support system for overcoming the formidable barriers to housing, recovery, and the pursuit of a self-directed life, all under the compassionate guidance of a Peer Support mentor.

In choosing Road2Home Safe Park, you not only secure a sanctuary for your vehicle, but you become an integral part of our vibrant community. We warmly extend an invitation for you to engage in any of the programs or opportunities we offer. Your participation is entirely voluntary, but it is a sincere invitation from us.

Our foundation lies in the establishment of the Road2Home Safe Parking Program, designed to provide a secure haven for the unhoused residents of Vancouver who find themselves with no alternative but to seek refuge in their vehicles. Beyond a place to park, rest, and sleep without the constant specter of harassment or the threat of trespassing arrests, we aim to provide you with:

Dignity, community, respect, and accountability

For the safety and success of this program, we have established the following policies and rules. Failure to abide by them may result in a warning and possible parking restriction. Violation of rules 1 and 2 will result in your immediate exit from the program and the Safe Park property. (Adults must initial after each of the following to indicate that they have read, understand and agree to abide by these guidelines.)

1. No weapons (especially firearms and knives) are allowed on the property, licensed, permitted or otherwise.
2. No violence, weapons or verbal abuse will be tolerated. Degrading ethnic, racist, sexist or homophobic remarks will not be tolerated.



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3. No littering. Keep your area tidy and clean. Use the available trash receptacles [insert explanation of acceptable trash disposal procedure here].
4. If your car leaks oil, please clean it up and resolve the issue. Kitty litter, dustpan and broom are provided.
5. Respect the quiet hours of 10:00pm to 8:00 am. Outside quiet hours, the volume of audio or video devices must not disturb neighbors.
6. Don't leave your vehicle unattended for more than 48 hours. Cars left unattended without letting the staff know for 7 days will be towed.
7. Only authorized guests may occupy the lot. Please do not invite friends or acquaintances.
8. Park in designated area only and only occupy only one spot. When space allows, leave one parking spot open between neighboring vehicles to give your neighbors privacy.
9. Keep facilities clean and tidy after use.
10. Accompany minor children when they exit your vehicle. You are responsible for their safety.
11. Respect and take care to not disturb the host property, neighbors and fellow guests.
12. You are to attend the monthly Safe Park community meeting where a hot meal will be provided. Parking community issues will be addressed and you'll have the opportunity to check-in with service providers on your action plan.
13. Must display your safe parking pass in the windshield of your vehicle while parked in lot.
no open flames.
14. Smoke in designated areas only. Dispose of cigarette butts in provided containers.
15. Pets must be leashed or kept in vehicles. Pet waste must be disposed of in a sealed/tied off plastic bag in the trash receptacle.
16. RVs, campers or 5th wheels are permitted.



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A copy of the Thrive2Survive Safe Park parking code of conduct has been given to me, and I agree to abide by it. I understand that any violation of these rules may result in a warning or immediate suspension of my privileges to park at Thrive2Survive' Safe Park.
