GARDENERS GALORE

Riveridge has invited a Master Gardener from Clark College to speak at the Spring Meeting. We will hear about best practices for tending our trees, lawns and flowers. We will discuss how native plants help to thrive our local pollinators and birds. Neighbors are encouraged to check out our Native Plant Habitat at the west end of 13th Street. The poppies, asters, stonecrop, snow drops, honeysuckle and monkey flowers delight the eye and astonish the nose.

Vancouver officials are in Phase 3 (Design Improvements) for the project to improve safety and traffic flow on McGillivray Blvd. Although some controversy still surrounds the city's plan to revamp McGillivray Blvd, construction appears to be on track to begin sometime in 2024.
