<b>OK for the chipper</b>	<b>Please NO</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Branches, twigs, tree pruning (up to 4" in diameter)</li><li>• Tree limbs (up to 4" in diameter)</li><li>• Trunks</li><li>• Woody debris does not need to be dried prior to chipping</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Juniper, arborvitae, ivy, vines, bamboo and blackberry briars get tangled in machinery</li><li>• Leaves or grass clippings</li><li>• Pine needles</li><li>• Rocks and dirt, or large stumps</li><li>• Painted or treated wood</li></ul>
