Clark County Property Taxes?

Property Tax Relief Programs

Washington's State Constitution, in combination with Clark County Codes and Ordinances, provide limited property tax relief to specific classes of individuals.

These programs typically fall into either a reduction applied to their property taxes, or the ability to defer a part of their property taxes.

Are you eligible for one of these programs?

- 1) Property Tax Exemption for Seniors and People with Disabilities
- 2) Property Tax Deferral for Seniors and People with Disabilities
- 3) Property Tax Deferral for Homeowners with Limited Income
