What permits or licenses do I need?

- ☐ City zoning, building, fire and sign permits and a City business license
- ☐ A food license permit, plus other applications and forms from the Clark County Public Health Department (clark.wa.gov/public-health/foodservice-establishment)
- ☐ A business license from Washington State Labor and Industries (business.wa.gov)
- ☐ A Washington state liquor license, if you will be serving alcohol (lcb.wa.gov/licensing/licensing-services)

Do I need a design professional?

You may need to hire a design professional based on the scope of work for your project. Contact the City Permit Center to find out.

What type of plans do I need to submit?

- □ Complete floor plans
- ☐ Kitchen equipment layout, including all equipment specifications
- □ Restrooms
- Mechanical Plan
- Type I or Type II Hood, including a Roof Plan
- Plumbing plans

What is the process after I submit my plans?

Multiple departments will review your application and plans:

- · Building safety · Fire
- EngineeringZoning
- · Sewer system development fee review

Further information may be required. After your fee is paid, your permit will be issued.
