- NO Hazardous chemicals, cleaners, paint, stains or fluids such as gasoline, oil or antifreeze
- NO TVs, computers or electronics.
- NO CFL or fluorescent tube lights
- NO Tires
- NO very LARGE items such as boats or hot tubs
