

**AMENDMENT to the CONTRACT
for 800 MHz, SIMULCAST AND TRUNKING RADIO SERVICES**

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT FOR 800 MHz, SIMULCAST AND TRUNKING RADIO SERVICES is entered into effective the 3rd day of October, 2006 by and between Clark County, Washington ("COUNTY") and City of Vancouver ("USER")

WHEREAS, COUNTY entered into a Contract for 800 MHz, Simulcast and Trunking Radio Services with the City of Vancouver on April 28, 1997, (Auditor's File No 9705009) ("the 1997 Interlocal") and,

WHEREAS, COUNTY has pursuant to Section 1 of the 1997 Interlocal designated Clark Regional Emergency Services Agency ("CRESA") as the administrator for the 800 MHz System; and,

WHEREAS, USER maintains a cache of Regional Resource Radios which are to be used for Region IV response capability and are not intended for daily operations use and are not designated solely for Agency use. Region IV response capability includes both the use of the resources within Region IV by Region IV personnel and the use of the resources by non-Region IV personnel responding to assist with incidents within Region IV; and,

WHEREAS, CRESA has revised the previously established rate structure for Regional Resource Radios;

NOW, THEREFORE, COUNTY and USER agree to this Amendment as follows:

There is added to Section 3 (Compensation) to the 1997 Interlocal a new subsection 5 to read as follows:

- 5 As approved in CRESA Staff Report 2005-23 on August 4, 2005, there will be no monthly radio system access charges for Regional Resource Radios. The initial template and programming will be free of charge. Any subsequent template changes and programming requests will be charged at the CRESA shop rate and paid by the requesting agency

This Amendment supersedes all previous amendments. All the remaining terms and conditions of the Contract for 800 MHz, Simulcast and Trunking Radio Services previously entered into by the parties shall remain in full force and effect
