Things to Know Before You Register

- The registration deadline is 9 a.m. the Thursday before camp starts.
- NEW: Refund requests must be made 4 weeks prior to the start of each week of camp.
- You are allowed to use DDA/DSHS respite funds for these programs. Please reach out to your DDD/DSHS caseworker or visit www.cityofvancouver.us/inclusion to complete the online form to enroll using respite funds. Registrations paid for with personal funds will not be refunded to use respite funds.
- For indoor activities, camp will be divided into pods of 10 campers with 2 staff. The pods will come together for large group activities outside. Participants will need to bring a snack, lunch and drinks.
- After registering you will receive an email from ePACT to fill out a participant registration form. This must be filled out for first time participants and confirmed as current for returning participants.
- Participants who need one-on-one assistance for personal care may bring their own caregiver. Caregivers must be age 18+ and complete a background check. For information on ADA, accommodation, or accessibility information visit www.cityofvancouver.us/inclusion.

Using C-VAN for Transportation to Access to Recreation Programs

- The participant must be a qualified C-VAN rider for Vancouver Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services (VPRCS) to schedule their ride.
- C-VAN ride requests must be made 14 days prior to the program start date.
- Requests must be made at the time of registration. If the ATR program registration is completed less than 14 days prior to the start of the program, the ride is not eligible to be booked through VPRCS.
- VPRCS schedules these rides as a courtesy to our ATR participants.
- All inquiries, comments or concerns regarding C-VAN transportation beyond the initial request for transportation to the VPRCS program should be directed to C-TRAN customer service at 360-695-8918 or refer to the C-VAN Rider Agreement. VPRCS cannot assist beyond providing the ride schedule.
