## Citywide EV Infrastructure Strategy



Residents and businesses are discovering the benefits of switching to low- and no-carbon vehicles in Vancouver. To support this transition, the City is developing a Citywide Electric Vehicle (EV) Infrastructure Strategy.

The EV Strategy will:

- Set priorities for EV infrastructure investments and incentives.
- Identify programs and policies to ensure a smooth and equitable transition to electric mobility for all communities.
- Outline actions that the City will take over the next 5 years to achieve its goals.
- Define roles and responsibilities for the City and partners.
