What's Accepted at a Neighborhood Cleanup?

- **Bulky Items:** Items too big for your garbage cart such as rug, kiddie pool, furniture, small appliances
- **Scrap Metal:** Metal grills, lawn chairs, mowers, etc. **MUST** be drained of gas, oil, etc. **NO** refrigerators, freezers or AC units. (No freon.)
- **Yard Debris:** Branches, leaves, vines, bramble, etc.

What's NOT Accepted?

- **NO** Household trash or contractor waste
- **NO** Concrete, rocks, sod or dirt
- **NO** Home remodel debris, tiles, drywall, etc.
- **NO** Roofing shingles or roofing materials
- **NO** tires
- **NO** Hazardous chemicals, cleaners, paint, stains or fluids such as gasoline, oil or antifreeze
- **NO** TVs, computers or electronics
- **NO** CFL or fluorescent tube lights
- **NO** very **LARGE** items such as boats and hot tubs
