What You <u>CAN</u> Bring

Bulky Items – Rugs, small appliances, kiddie pools, furniture, brooms, other items too large for your garbage cart

- Scrap Metal BBQs, bicycles, lawn furniture, mowers, drained car parts or small engines, metal appliances
- Yard Debris Leaves, grass clippings, small branches, vines, bramble, arborvitae, juniper, bamboo, and garden trimmings
- Donations Open House Ministries will be onsite to accept donations of new and gently used clothing, household items, and furniture

What You <u>CANNOT</u> Bring

- Household trash or bagged garbage (please put this in your bin)
- Contractor/remodel debris (drywall, tiles, flooring, fencing, etc.)
- Large amounts of concrete, cement, rocks, sod, or dirt
- Roofing materials/shingles
- Hazardous waste (paint, chemicals, oils, cleaners, fuels, pesticides)
- Electronics (TVs, computers, monitors, tablets) recycle free at <u>ecyclewashington.org</u>
- CFLs and fluorescent tube lights recycle free at <u>lightrecycle.org</u>
- Extra-large items (boats, hot tubs, etc.) haul these directly to a transfer station

LEAF BINS

To help keep our streets clear, safe, and storm drains flowing, the City provides leaf bins during the fall season. A leaf bin is a large, shared dumpster-style container placed in the neighborhood for residents to drop off excess leaves from their yards and streets.

Please remember: Leaves only! No branches, grass clippings, trash, or other yard debris. Come to the Neighborhood Clean up to dump those.
