# □ Store paint, brushes, and rollers away from storm drains □ Keep lids tightly sealed when not in use Spill & Waste Management □ Properly dispose of paint waste, rags, and used containers ➤ Clark County's Recycling A to Z webpage can be used to learn how to dispose of waste ➤ Wash paint tools or containers into a bucket or kiddie pool to be dumped into a sink, lawn, or privately owned landscaping. Wash water cannot enter the stormwater system. ➤ Preventing paint from entering our storm system protects the Columbia River! ○ Department of Ecology's paints and coating webpage □ If paint or wash water enters the storm drain, contact 360-487-8177 for 24/7 support Post-Work Inspection & Clean Up □ Wipe up any wet paint splatter or residue □ Sweep the area and dispose of waste in the appropriate waste receptacles
